


Toward Zero Deaths

- In 2017 NJ had 184 pedestrian fatalities which accounted for almost 30% of all traffic fatalities (625) nearly doubling the national average of 16%. *NJSP Stats
- Annually, nearly 6,000 pedestrians are killed in motor vehicle crashes nationwide. *GHSA Pedestrian Traffic Fatalities by State 2017 Prelim Data
- NJ is designated "focus"state for pedestriansby FHWA


Behavior Change
