



### Placemaking Zone Immediate Activities ~ CPP

- Do a demonstration project
- Plan annual Seasonal Parklets
- Paint security grates
- Clean and declutter store windows
- Steam clean sidewalk (private or with City)
- Create an organization to manage the Pueblo Passaic District (= CPP)




#### **Use of Density Bonus for Community Benefits**

The 26 North Street Rehabilitation Site Vacant for over ten years

- 1. Add six to 12 trees
- 2. Add street lamps.
- 3. Install a bus shelter
- 4. Add planter, lighted bollards and litter and recycling receptacles
- 5. Install a decorative solid fence
- 6. City public art project to paint the stretch of blank concrete wall
- 7. Outfit proposed and existing streetlights with banner posts
- 8. Change public park by installing brightly colored children's play equipment and install mounted security cameras
- 10. Paint the sidewalks across from the station the color red to match the brick pavers
- 11. Provide for additional public parking on-site (minimum of 15 spaces).

Density Bonus Height, Area, Yard and Structure Requirements (Must meet community benefit requirements in Section f above)



Maximum structure height

22 stories/250 feet




